

**D3 Prep Clinic**  
April 5-6, 2008  
Rainbow Meadow Farm

**Objective:**

This prep clinic is aimed at helping the D2 candidate prepare for their D3 rating through both mounted and unmounted instruction.

**Who may attend:**

D2's, others by application

**Instructors:**

**Tentative Schedule:**

**Saturday, April 5:** 7:00am: Arrive and get horse settled (Friday night arrival can be arranged. Please see the "stabling section" for more information.) 7:30am: Meeting over breakfast. Breakfast will be followed by morning mounted and unmounted instruction. Lunch, followed by afternoon mounted and unmounted instruction. Dinner and games.

**Sunday, April 6:** 7:30 am: Meeting over breakfast. Breakfast will be followed by mounted and unmounted instruction. We anticipate completing the day about 3pm.

**Clinic Fee:**

\$120 fee includes instruction, meals, and stabling.

**Clinic includes (subject to change due to scheduling requirements):**

- ◆ 3 mounted lessons (expected group size of 4-5 riders). Mounted Lessons are anticipated to consist of flat, cross-country and show jumping.
- ◆ 3 unmounted sessions
- ◆ 1 unmounted Saturday evening session with the whole group
- ◆ Bandaging session
- ◆ Food: 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 1 dinner, snacks (please see food section)

**Stabling:**

- ❖ We will be staying in Rainbow Meadow Farm's "Guest Barn", which consists of 17 permanent stalls.
- ❖ Stall cards are required and must be posted before you leave your horse in the barn. Contact phone numbers (cell and where you are staying for the night are key)
- ❖ Stalls will be assigned. Initial bedding is provided with stall fee. Additional bedding should be brought with participant.
- ❖ Prior to departure, your "stall deposit" will be returned once the stall has been stripped and it has been checked.
- ❖ Stalls are available on Friday evening if desired. There is an additional stabling fee of \$25 for Friday night. Please be sure to indicate this on your registration.

**Directions to Rainbow Meadow Farm:**

Take Exit 88 (Tenino/Rochester exit). Head East towards Tenino. Continue about 2-2.25 miles to 183rd Ave, Turn Left onto 183rd Ave (Next to the South Sound Speedway). Continue about 0.25 mile to Danby St (first Right turn), Turn Right onto Danby. Continue 1 mile, you will come to a 90 degree turn to the right (Danby turning into Leitner). Ahead about 200 ft you will see a 4 rail white fence on your left side. Stay on the road and follow the fence up to the yellow barns.

**Food:**

- Saturday's Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner, snacks and dessert and Sunday's Breakfast, Lunch, and snacks will be provided for the participant and 1 support person. If additional support people would like meals, they can be purchased for \$5/meal or \$20 for duration.

**Lodging/Camping:**

Participants can camp on site (no fee). Limited electrical hook-ups are available for \$20/night. Local hotel are available within a 6 mile drive. Please contact for listings.

**Bring:**

- Overnight supplies for horse and rider
- Bandaging supplies
- Stall card (please email with questions)
- Regular tack for flat and jumping work
- Dress in layer and be ready for potential rain (thank you Northwest Washington)
- Family sized item to add to food list. Please contact Annie ([RainbowMeadows@aol.com](mailto:RainbowMeadows@aol.com)) for list of items. This is how we can keep costs as low as possible.

**Deadline:**

Registration deadline is March 15 or until full. Once clinic is full, we will retain completed registration materials to serve as a waiting list for cancellations. Once the registration is received, we will email you with a conformation and any additional information.

**Cancellations:**

Refunds may be given if we can fill the space from our waiting list. If you register and must cancel, we will substitute from our waiting list.

**Volunteers:**

**Arrival:**
