

Pony club Polocrosse Points challenge

The Pony club Polocrosse points challenge is a program that allows pony clubbers of all levels to compete on a different level in Polocrosse. Each pony clubber that signs up by the dead line of February 28, 2008 will be able to start earning points for every practice, clinic, and tournament they participate in. At the end of the year the points will be counted and an award will be given to the pony clubber with the most points.

Rules:

- 1. Fill out entry and have it back into Rebecca Cooper by February 28, 2008 Entry's will be available at the NW Pony Club website or the Washington state polocrosse yahoo group in the files section.**
- 2. When your entry is received you will get back a log to be signed by the adult either teaching the lesson or sponsoring the clinic, tournament or rally.**
- 3. Logs must be returned to Rebecca Cooper by November 30 for scoring.**

To have a lesson or clinic qualify it must be a regular lesson that is either sponsored by a pony club or a member of WSPA (Washing state Polocrosse association)

Points will be awarded as follows:

1 point for every lesson attended

2 points for any clinics attended

4 points for every tournament or rally attended
